NOTICE TO CONTRACTOR – PRE-BID SITE VISIT

A Pre-Bid Site Visit will be held at 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, February 24, 2011 at 4 Brewery Street in New Haven, Connecticut. Prospective bidders shall park along the curb line of Long Wharf Street adjacent to the New Haven Post Office rear parking lot and across from the security booth at the east entrance to the New Haven Rail Yard. Prospective bidders will be escorted through the yard to the project site.

Work for this Project involves areas that are part of the railroad right-of-way and access to the area is restricted. Therefore, all bidders are strongly encouraged to attend this Pre-Bid Site Visit. **There will be no other opportunity afforded to bidders to inspect the Project site.** The Pre-Bid Site Visit will include a review of the project site, of the limitations of operations, and of the necessary compliance with Metro-North Railroad requirements for the Project.

All attendees must bring hard hats, safety vests, safety glasses, and safety shoes to the site visit. No one will be allowed on the site visit without wearing this safety gear. Those planning to attend must contact Mr. Philip J. Melchionne, Contract Section, prior to the Pre-Bid Site Visit, DOTContract@ct.gov for confirmation. You must provide your name, name of firm, phone number, and number of attendees. Bidders are advised that no questions will be entertained at the site visit. The Department of Transportation hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, qualified Disadvantaged Business Enterprises or Small Contractor or Small Contractor Minority Business Enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and that they will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, national origin, sex, sexual orientation, mental retardation or physical disability including but not limited to blindness, in consideration for an award.

Prospective bidders must be prequalified with the Department of Transportation and have on-file a sworn Statement (Form CON 16). In order to help ensure that they may become prequalified in time for the bid opening for a given contract, contractors should be certain to return the form with all necessary information, signatures and notarizations to the Manager at least thirty (30) calendar days before requesting a bid proposal form for that contract. All prospective bidders wishing to obtain Proposal Forms must also submit a completed Qualification Affidavit (Part "C") when requesting a bid proposal.

If the Qualification Affidavit and the Contractor's Statement are found satisfactory, the proposal could be picked up or mailed to the contractor after three working days from the date of submittal.

NOTE: Prequalification status is confirmed every time a contractor applies for a proposal. All Proposals must be on the form furnished by the Department of Transportation and must be requested for the above named project(s). Bid Proposals are not included in the Plans and Specifications and are non-transferable.

The minimum rates to be paid labor of the various classifications shall be in accordance with current schedule of wages established by the State Labor Commissioner as provided in the General Statutes of Connecticut, as revised. The Contract Wage Certification Form is to be submitted to the Labor Commissioner before the award of the contract.

It is Department Policy that Payment and Performance Bonds and Contracts must be signed by the Bonding Companies and Contractors in the Office of the Department's Contract Section located in Room 2410, 2800 Berlin Turnpike, Newington, Connecticut.

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All bidders are required to inform themselves fully of the conditions relating to the construction and labor under which the work will be or is now being performed and the contractor shall employ, as far as possible, such methods and means in the carrying out of this work as will not cause interruption or interference with any other contractor.

NOTE: Any Contractor or Subcontractor engaged in surface preparation and/or coating application must be certified by the Steel Structures Painting Council.

NOTE: Except when otherwise specified in the bid documents, no proposal will be considered unless; (a) it is accompanied by a proposal guaranty in the form of a bond from a surety company, satisfactory to the Commissioner, on the form furnished by the Department, in an amount equal to at least one-third of the amount of

the bid; or (b) the bidder has on file in the Contract Section a current annual bid bond, satisfactory to the Commissioner, on the form provided by the Department for an amount equal to at least one-third of the aggregate amount of all current bids by the bidder for the Department's construction contracts.

At the time of the bid opening, the surety must be a corporate surety licensed by the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Connecticut and must hold a Certificate of Authority as an acceptable Surety and/or Reinsuring Company acceptable to the Federal Department of Treasury. The surety's underwriting limitation must not be less than the full amount required by the bond, itself.

CONTRACTORS that find discrepancies and/or errors in or between plans, specifications, quantities and other matters must immediately notify the Manager of Contracts in writing not less than twenty-eight (28) days before the scheduled bid opening.

The Department, prior to the awarding of any contract, may require further financial and other information from any applicant who becomes the low bidder for that contract. The Commissioner of Transportation reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

NOTICE TO CONTRACTOR - RESTRICTED ACCESS TO SECURITY CONTRACT DOCUMENTS

Due to the sensitive nature of the information contained in the documents, the Contract documents (plans and specifications) for the Security portion of this project shall be restricted in their availability to bidders. These plans and specifications will be made available at the Department's Office of Contracts for viewing by prospective bidders. Prospective bidders shall contact the Office of Contracts at 860-594-3127 or 860-549-3129 to arrange to view the Security plans and specifications. They are available for viewing Monday through Friday, 8:30 am through 4:00 pm, at the ConnDOT Office of Contracts, 2800 Berlin Turnpike, Newington, CT. The plans and specifications are available for viewing only. No copies can be made of the plans or specifications. The plans and specifications cannot be removed from ConnDOT offices. No extension of the bid period or postponement of the Bid Opening date will be considered as a result of this restriction.

This restriction applies to the Bidding phase only. Once the Contract has been awarded, three (3) hard copy sets of the security plans and specifications will be provided to the Contractor for use during construction, digital files will not be provided for these documents. The Contractor will be required to sign a Confidentiality statement furnished by the Engineer that requires the Contractor to agree to limit further distribution of these plans and specifications to only those parties that are required to possess the documents in order to perform Contract work. Making additional copies of these plans and specifications is prohibited. NOTICE TO CONTRACTOR – PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The following describes, in general terms, work to be performed by the Contractor. It is not a comprehensive description of the Contract scope.

The Project consists of the construction of the Independent Wheel True Facility (IWT) located at the New Haven Rail Yard in New Haven Connecticut as shown and described in the Contract.

The IWT is a single story pile-supported steel-framed building with a single railroad track passing throughout. The track allows access to a dual-axle tandem wheel true machine that will be used to re-profile the wheels of the fleet of rail cars used on the New Haven Line. The track enters the shop through large roll-up doors on either end of the building. The wheel true machine is housed in a large pit area requiring excavation below the ground water level. The wheel true machine will be procured separately and the Contractor must coordinate with the machine supplier to ensure accurate and efficient machine installation.

The shop is open throughout with the exception of a series of rooms along the northern perimeter which serve specialized functions such as electrical, fire protection, IT, toilet facilities, etc.

The IWT will be constructed partially on the site of a former Power Plant, demolished in 2008. There are elements of the former concrete foundation that must be removed in order to accomplish the construction. In addition, an existing electrical duct bank passes through the footprint of the IWT which must be identified and protected from damage.

Subsurface gas, electric, water, sewer, communications and drainage lines will be installed to service the IWT as well as future projects on the site. Modifications to the existing track, catenary and communications systems are included as well as construction of access roads and parking areas.

The IWT will be constructed within an active rail yard, adjacent to active tracks with overhead electrified catenary. In addition, there will be other construction contractors engaged in work in the yard simultaneously. Staged construction will be required to relocate existing parking areas used by railroad employees prior to the beginning of building construction.

Environmental work associated with this facility may include work with polluted soils and groundwater, as further specified in the NOTICE TO CONTRACTOR – ENVIRONMENTAL INVESTIGATIONS. Such work may also include PCB's, lead and asbestos abatement and the removal and disposal of regulated items as indicated in the NOTICE TO CONTRACTOR – DEMOLITION & HAZARDOUS MATERIALS ABATEMENT.

NOTICE TO CONTRACTOR - METRO-NORTH RAILROAD RECOMMENDED PRACTICE FOR CONSTRUCTION OF TRACK DOCUMENTS

The track installation to be performed by the Contractor is to be performed using the standards contained in the document entitled "Metro-North Recommended Practice for Construction of Track". This is commonly referred to as the "MW-4".

Due to the sensitive nature of the information contained in this document, all respective bidders will be required to sign the Confidentiality Agreement attached to this notice prior to receiving a copy of the MW-4.

The MW-4 will be made available at the Connecticut Department of Transportation's Office of Contracts, in electronic format for prospective bidders, Monday through Friday, 8:30 am through 4:00 pm, 2800 Berlin Turnpike, Newington, CT. CONFIDENTIALITY AGREEMENT

Name and Address of Company Executing this Agreement:

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Transportation Authority Metro-North Commuter Railroad Company (hereinafter referred to as "Metro-North") issued a Project Solicitation requesting bids for the Diesel Storage Yard, Project 301-0110 (the "Project Solicitation"); and

WHEREAS, the Company executing this Agreement (hereinafter referred to as the "Contractor") is considering submitting a bid or is an agent or representative of a Contractor that is considering submitting a bid in response to the Project Solicitation; and

WHEREAS, Metro-North has agreed to provide the Contractor with information and documents that Metro-North considers to be confidential (hereinafter referred to as "Confidential Information");

NOW, THEREFORE, the Contractor agrees as follows:

1. Metro-North will provide the Contractor with access to and copies of Confidential Information solely for the purposes of the Contractor deciding whether to submit a bid in response to the Project Solicitation and/or preparing a bid in response to the Project Solicitation.
2. The Contractor agrees to keep in confidence and prevent the use (except for a disclosure pursuant to Paragraph 3, below) or the disclosure to any person or persons outside the Contractor (or outside another Contractor that has also executed and submitted to Metro-North an agreement in the same form as this Agreement), and limit the disclosure inside the Contractor (or inside another Contractor that has also executed and submitted to Metro-North an agreement in the same form as this Agreement) to employees having a need-to-know, of all Confidential Information provided to the Contractor in connection with the Project Solicitation.

10. The rights, obligations, and other interests of the Contractor shall not be assigned by the Contractor, in whole or in part, without the prior written consent of Metro-North and any purported assignment of same shall be void. This Agreement shall be binding on successors and permitted assigns of the Contractor.

11. This Agreement is the entire agreement with respect to nondisclosure of Confidential Information pertaining to the conduct of business stated above and supersedes all prior agreements and understandings with respect to this subject. This Agreement may be amended only by written agreement executed by the Contractor and Metro-North.

12. The Contractor shall perform its obligations hereunder without charge to Metro-North.

13. The Consultant shall notify Metro-North promptly, to be followed by written notice of any loss or misplacement of Confidential Information, in whatever form.

14. All hardware, software, documents and other information received by or generated by the Contractor in connection with the Project Solicitation, unless otherwise indicated, shall be considered Confidential Information.

15. The Contractor shall send via registered mail or hand delivery all Confidential Information and any copies thereof, in whatever form, promptly upon Metro-North's request.
