

INVITATION TO BID

Sealed Bids for Bid No. 09-11-12-04 "Hawthorne Terrace Water System Improvements Contract No. 3, Modifications to Well Houses" Danbury, CT, Project No. 03-17C will be received at Danbury City Hall, Purchasing Agent's office, 155 Deer Hill Avenue, Danbury, Connecticut 06810 until 10:00 a.m., Tuesday, November 1, 2011. Prior to the public opening of the bids, any bid submitted may be withdrawn by the bidder if said bidder discovers mathematical or clerical errors in his bid. Any such bid withdrawal may be made without penalty or prejudice. After the bids are opened, all offers will be considered firm for a period of ninety days and no bid may be withdrawn for any reason during that period except for such cause as the City of Danbury in its sole discretion deems sufficient.

The work consists of all labor, tools, materials and equipment necessary to complete the modifications to the upper and lower well houses of the Hawthorne Terrace water system; including furnishing and installing an atmospheric storage tank, building modifications and chemical treatment.

A bid bond in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the amount of the bid shall accompany each bid. A non-collusion statement for Prime Contractors and any addendum acknowledgements must also be submitted at the time of the bid.

A performance bond in an amount equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the accepted bid will be required.

Beginning Monday, October 3, 2011, plans and specifications (Contract Documents) may be obtained at the Purchasing Agent's office, City Hall, 155 Deer Hill Avenue, Danbury, Connecticut 06810. Bidders may obtain complete sets of plans and specifications for a nonrefundable payment of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per set.

A pre-bid conference for Bidders will be held on October 18, 2011 at 10:30 a.m. at the Lower Well House, Forty Acre Mountain Road, Danbury, CT.

The City of Danbury is an equal opportunity and affirmative action purchaser and bids from all vendors, including those from enterprises owned by minorities and women, are encouraged.

The City of Danbury reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids and to award the contract to the bidder deemed to be for its best interest.
