GENERAL

- 1. Is sharing existing technology between participating organizations of the collaboration an appropriate project for this RFA?**

The NCIGP supports one-time infrastructure costs to implement consolidation of programs and services resulting from the collaboration of two or more nonprofit organizations. The term "programs and services" is broadly defined to include joint ventures involving shared business operations, functions, or services. The applicant is responsible for determining the appropriateness of a project based on the requirements of the RFA.

ELIGIBILITY

- 2. The eligibility requirements states that "Each participant organization of the collaboration must be registered as a 501(c) (3) organization and in good standing with the State of Connecticut and all regulatory authorities". If a participant organization is under a consent order from a state agency does the organization meet the eligibility requirements?**

The eligibility requirements of the RFA do not prohibit an organization under a consent order from a state agency from submitting an application.
