DESCRIPTION: Liquid Bituminous Material

BIDDERS NOTE:

Addendum #2 has been issued to Bid #12PSX0331 to post questions with answers received into DAS/Procurement by the due date of October 12, 2012.

Question: On pages 7, 8, 9 and 10 of the bid sheets, please clarify the square yard prices under letter A: are they by total project size or are they by square yards per day? They way it is written now, there is no way to tell. If it were to be clarified, we suggest that the square yards per day choice would be fairer to both contractors and owners. Consider a project that has more than 50,000 square yards, but consists of several small quantity roads a few miles apart where the large quantities per day are not possible. This type of quantity range bid would put to the rest some of the issues we have had in the past.

Answer: The square yard price ranges reflect project size and not square yards per day. No price under item #4 is on a “per day” basis. When required by ConnDOT, the price per square yard for Traffic Control is added to the price per square yard for liquid surface treatment complete in place. Polymer Additive is the actual number of square yards where a Polymer Additive was applied. Pretreated Stone is the actual number of square yards where applied.
