As security, each bid must be accompanied by a CERTIFIED CHECK payable, to the order of TREASURER of the State of Connecticut, or the bid must be accompanied by a BID BOND in the amount of 10% of the amount of the bid. All bonds required for this Project shall be acceptable to the Department of Energy & Environmental Protection and, as a minimum, issued through a bonding company licensed to transact such business in the State of Connecticut and named on the current list of "Surety Companies Acceptable on Federal Bonds" as published in the "Treasury Department Circular 570".

Performance and Labor and Material Bonds to be furnished by the bidder awarded the contract shall be an amount not less than 100% of the contract price. Project Description:

Install a 6,000-gallon concrete fuel storage tank and all the associated concrete pads, walkways and utility conduits to render the fuel tank fully functional. Remove the existing underground fuel storage tanks, the fueling island, fuel delivery systems, associated piping and conduits. Grade the area of the former tanks and install bituminous concrete pavement for additional parking at the facility.
