

EXHIBIT A.1

Description of Goods and Services for **Biodegradable Asphalt Solvent**

I. Contractor Responsibility:

- A. Contractor shall provide Biodegradable Asphalt Solvent (“BAS”) to the Client Agency in accordance with the terms and conditions of this Contract.
- B. The Contractor shall deliver the BAS to the Client Agency, at any time and from time to time during the term of the Contract at the request of the Client Agency, in either fifty-five (55) gallon drums on pallets or in five (5) gallon containers on pallets. Each shall be accessible by forklift.
- C. The Contractor shall provide at least twenty-four hour advance notice of delivery to Client Agency.
- D. The Contractor shall, throughout the term of the Contract, maintain any and all licenses or approvals necessary or required to be an authorized manufacturer or distributor of the type of BAS that is the subject of the Contract.

II. Material Specifications:

- A. The BAS shall be a biodegradable solvent for cleaning equipment and shall not be a truck release agent.
- B. The BAS shall emulsify in water
- C. The BAS shall be non-carcinogenic.
- D. The BAS shall not contain any petroleum distillates or chlorinated hydrocarbon solvents.
- E. The BAS shall not violate any United States Environmental Protection Agency (E.P.A) guidelines and specifications as well as any state and Federal guidelines pertaining to the sale, purchase and use of biodegradable asphalt solvent.
- F. The ingredients and composition of the BAS will be subject to the review and approval of the Client Agency at any time and from time to time.

III. Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS):

- A. Contractors shall provide a Material Safety Data Sheet(s) (“MSDS”) for the each delivery of BAS. Each MSDS will be in form and substance satisfactory to the Client Agency and provide detailed information about the chemical nature of the BAS, such as physical and chemical properties, and health, safety, fire and environmental hazards.

IV. Training on Product Use and Application:

- A. The Contractor shall provide training to Client Agency personnel designated by the Client Agency in the safe application and use of the biodegradable asphalt solvent at no cost to the Client Agency. Such training will occur at the discretion of the Client Agency and must be held within the state of Connecticut at a location acceptable to Client Agency.
