

LEGAL NOTICE

The Norwalk Transit District is seeking to engage a Consultant to provide engineering services for the preparation of contract plans and documents for the following transportation project:

STATE PROJECT 102-350 NORWALK RIVER VALLEY TRAIL – PHASE 2

This project involves the production of design and construction documents for the construction of a multi-purpose trail from Union Park to New Canaan Avenue, a distance of approximately 1 mile. The Consulting Engineer may also be required to provide survey, prepare environmental documents and perform construction inspection. The construction cost is expected to be in the range of \$2.5M - \$3.0M, based on 2012 prices. The City of Norwalk- Department of Public Works will manage the project on behalf of the Norwalk Transit District. The consultant Engineer will be evaluated and selected based on design and technical competence, the capacity and capability to perform the work within the time allotted, past record of performance, and knowledge of Federal, State, City and Norwalk Transit District procedures, appropriately weighted in descending order of importance. Firms responding to this request should be of adequate size and sufficiently staffed to perform the assignment described above.

The Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) sub consultant goal will be no less than 10% percent of the original agreement value. The selected firm must meet all City, State and Federal affirmative action and equal employment opportunity practices.

A letter of interest, together with 6 copies of general information on the firm and proposed sub consultants, the firm's brochure, current GSA SF 330, experience of the firms, including a resume of key personnel should be addressed to:

Personnel in responsible charge of the project will be required to possess and maintain a valid Connecticut Professional Engineer's license.
