Sealed bids are invited and will be received by the Town of Wolcott, until 2:00 p.m., July 24, 2014 at the Wolcott Town Hall, Mayor's Office, 10 Kenea Avenue, Wolcott Connecticut, at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read aloud.

Proposals must be submitted on the forms provided and in a sealed envelope plainly marked with the appropriate title, "HEATING UPGRADES". The proposed work includes asbestos abatement, removal of an oil fired hot water boiler and oil fired domestic water heater and 2 – 275 gallon fuel storage tanks. The installation of a combination propane fired condensing gas fired boiler with domestic water capabilities and the installation of 2 mini split ductless heat pumps and all related piping.

A mandatory pre-bid conference to review the project will be held at the Wolcott Food Pantry, 358 Woodtick Road, Wolcott, CT, July 10, 2014, at 9:00 a.m. All prospective bidders are required to attend.

Attention of bidders is directed to certain requirements of this contract which require payment of Davis-Bacon wages, and compliance with certain local, state and federal requirements. This is a Federally funded project.

The Information for Bidders, Form of Bid, Specifications, and other contract documents may be obtained and examined at the Wolcott Town Hall, 10 Kenea Avenue, Wolcott, CT, Monday through Wednesday 8:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m., Thursday 8:00 a.m. – 5:30 p.m., and Friday 8:00 a.m. – 12:00.

Bids, to receive consideration, must be in the hands of the authorized representative, no later than the day and hour mentioned above.
