This addendum is issued to clarify items in the Bid document under Required Contract Terms, Specifications and to issue a revised Bid Form.

1) Required Contract Terms

Prevailing Wages (Page 3, Item #9) – Prevailing Wages are not in effect for this project.

2) Specifications

On page 1, Item #1.F, “Thiokol” is specified as the preferred joint sealant. However, the Town will accept an approved equal meeting Federal Specification TT-S-00227E, Class A, Type 1, Pourable Type II.

On page 2, Item #4.A, Expansion Joints and Cracks in Pool, please specify the manufacture’s name of the two (2) part sealant proposed for sealing any cracks in pool.

On page 3, Item #1.E, “Thiokol” is specified as the preferred joint sealant. However, the Town will accept an approved equal meeting Federal Specification TT-S-00227E, Class A, Type 1, Pourable Type II.

On page 4, Item #4.B, the Town will accept as an alternate to specified paint, two (2) coats of epoxy paint with a resolution to the pitting of the concrete with a separate cost.

On page 5, Item #4.E, the manufacturer recommends no more than 24 hours between application of coats of paint.

Please note that all other terms and conditions appearing in the original Invitation for Bid remain unchanged. Vendors are asked to sign, date and return this sheet **along with their bids** in order to verify their receipt of this addendum prior to the submission deadline.
