

## SECTION 02030

### TRAFFICPERSON

#### PART 1 - GENERAL

##### 1.01 DESCRIPTION OF WORK:

- A. Contractor shall provide the services of Trafficpersons of the type and number, and for such periods, as the CTDEEP approves for the control and direction of vehicular traffic and pedestrians. On a weekly basis, the Contractor shall inform the CTDEEP of their scheduled operations for the following week and the number of Trafficpersons requested. The CTDEEP shall review this schedule and approve the type and number of Trafficpersons required. If the Contractor changes or cancels any scheduled operations without prior notice of same as required by the agency providing the Trafficpersons, and such that Trafficperson services are no longer required, the Contractor will be responsible for payment at no cost to the Department of any show-up cost for any Trafficperson not used because of the change. Exceptions, as approved by the CTDEEP, may be granted for adverse weather conditions and unforeseeable causes beyond the control and without the fault or negligence of the Contractor. Trafficpersons assigned to a work site are to only take direction from the CTDEEP.

#### PART 3 - EXECUTION

##### 3.01 TRAFFICPERSONS:

- A. Scheduling the Work: The contractor shall schedule Uniformed Municipal Police Officers and Uniformed Flaggers necessary for the safe ingress and egress at the various access points the public roadway and as required by the municipalities where the work takes place.
- B. Uniformed Municipal Police Officers shall be sworn Municipal Police Officers or Uniformed Constables who perform criminal law enforcement duties from the Municipality in which the project is located. Their services will also include an official Municipal Police vehicle when required by the Municipality or requested by the CTDEEP. Uniformed Municipal Police Officers will be used on all non limited access highways. If Uniformed Municipal Police Officers are unavailable, other Trafficpersons may be used when authorized in writing by the CTDEEP.

Uniformed Municipal Police Officers and requested Municipal Police vehicles will be used at such locations and for such periods as the CTDEEP deems necessary to control

traffic operations and promote increased safety to motorists at access points to the construction sites.

- C. Uniformed Flagger: Uniformed Flaggers shall be persons who have successfully completed flagger training by the ATSSA, National Safety Council or other programs approved by the CTDEEP. A copy of the Flagger's training certificate shall be provided to the CTDEEP before the Flagger performs any work on the project. Services of Uniformed Flaggers shall include the following equip equipment: garments (including high visibility headgear) so as to be readily distinguishable as a Flagger in accordance with Standard 6E-2 of the MUTCD, and these specifications, and a STOP/SLOW paddle that is at least 18 inches (450 millimeters) in width with letters at least 6 inches (150 millimeters) high, mounted on a handle of sufficient length so that the bottom of the sign will be 6 feet (1.8 meters) above the ground, and conforms to Standard 6E-3 of the MUTCD and catalog number 387-80-9950 of the Catalog of Signs CDOT

Uniformed Flaggers will be used at such locations and for such periods as the CTDEEP deems necessary to control traffic operations.

## **PART 4 - COMPENSATION**

### **4.01 METHOD OF MEASUREMENT:**

- A. The work required under this Section will be measured for payment based on the actual invoiced cost to the Contractor. Contractor shall pay out of pocket cost and shall not be allowed to mark-up survey and testing costs for overhead, profit, or any other purpose. Total payments will not exceed the allowance amount specified in Paragraph 4.03.

### **4.02 BASIS OF PAYMENT:**

- A. The work required under this Section will be paid for at the actual invoiced cost to the Contractor. This cost shall include all equipment, fuel, tools, transportation and labor incidental thereto, up to the specified allowance amount unless otherwise directed by CTDEEP. Invoices submitted to CTDEEP for payment for survey and testing services shall include copies of all invoices submitted to the Contractor. Contractor shall pay out of pocket cost and shall not be allowed mark-up for overhead, profit, or any other purpose.
