INVITATION TO BID
THE CITY OF MERIDEN IS ACCEPTING SEALED BIDS FOR:
B016-17 Furniture, Furnishing and Equipment for Francis T. Maloney High School – Phase 3A**

Bids shall be submitted on forms and in the manner specified. Forms and specifications may be obtained from the Purchasing Department, 142 East Main Street, Meriden, CT 06450-8022. Bids will be accepted in Purchasing, Room 210, 142 East Main Street, Meriden, CT 06450-8022, until **2:00 P.M. on December 1, 2015** at which time they will be publicly opened and read. Any bid received after the time and date specified shall not be considered.

Each bid shall be accompanied by a Certified Check or Bid Bond in the amount of Ten (10%) percent of the amount bid. Bids shall be submitted in triplicate.

Vendors are invited to submit sealed bids on a contract for Furniture, Furnishings and Equipment for the Additions & Renovations at the Francis T. Maloney High School, 121 Gravel Street in Meriden, Connecticut. The work consists of Art and Music equipment as called for in bidding documents prepared by Fletcher Thompson Architects.

Bid Documents including Instructions to Bidders, Bid Forms, Form of Contract, Form of Bonds, General Conditions of the Contract and Specifications may be examined on or after November 9, 2015 between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M. daily; except Saturdays, Sundays and holidays.

Bid documents will be available electronically at no cost. Contact the Purchasing Department via email at purchasing@meridenct.gov to request documents. Printed copies will be available for a non-refundable fee of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) per set. Checks shall be payable to the City of Meriden. Bidders requesting that bid documents be sent to them shall provide their courier account number for billing.

Performance and Payment Bond for One Hundred Percent (100%) of the contract price, with a corporate surety approved by the City of Meriden, will be required of the lowest responsible bidder **for any awards exceeding \$100,000.00.**

The right is reserved to reject any or all bids in whole or in part, to award any item, or total bid and to waive informality or technical defects, if it is deemed to be in the best interest of the City of Meriden. No bidder may withdraw their bid within sixty (60) days of the date of the bid opening. Should there be reason why the contract cannot be awarded within the specified period; the time may be extended by mutual agreement between the City of Meriden and the bidder.
