

## SOLICITATION OF BIDS

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**Rimmon Street Reconstruction and Drainage Improvements,  
State Project No. 124-169 / Federal Aid Project No. 1124(003)  
Seymour, CT**

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The Town of Seymour, Connecticut is soliciting sealed bids for furnishing all labor, tools, materials and equipment required for Rimmon Street Reconstruction and Drainage Improvements, State Project No. 124-169 in Seymour.

The proposed project is located on Rimmon Street, and a short portion of Old Drive within mostly residential area. The proposed project length is approximately 3,000 feet beginning at its intersection with Route 67 and ending at the Beacon Falls Town line.

The proposed roadway improvements include full depth pavement reconstruction, concrete curbing where sidewalks are proposed and new drainage system for the entire project limit. In addition, new concrete sidewalks will replace the existing bituminous concrete sidewalk. The sidewalk will be reconstructed to meet ADA standards.

A non-mandatory pre-bid meeting will be held at 10:00 A.M. on September 21, 2016 at the Seymour Town Hall.

Sealed bids will be received by the Office of the First Selectman, 1 First Avenue, Seymour, CT, until 10:00 A.M. local time, on October 11, 2016. Bids will then be publicly opened and read aloud. No Bidder may withdraw their bid for a period of sixty (60) days after the date of Bid opening.

The Contract Documents, including bid specifications and drawings, are available for review at Universal Copy, LLC, 35 South Main Street, Naugatuck CT 06770. The Seymour Town Hall is open Monday – Friday 8:30 AM – 4:30 PM. A full set of these plans may be purchased at this location for \$240. Digital sets can be purchased for a fixed rate. A satisfactory Bid Bond or Certified Check, in the amount equal to five percent (5%) of the base bid, shall be submitted with each bid. Each Bid must include a 5% Bid Bond. The Bid Bond shall be made payable to Town of Seymour and shall be properly executed by the Bidder and acceptable sureties. All bonds must be sureties registered in the State of Connecticut.

Labor and Material Payment Bond and a Performance bond for one hundred (100%) percent of the contract price, with a corporate surety approved by the Town of Seymour, will be required of the lowest responsible bidder.

The Town of Seymour hereby notifies all bidders that this contract has been assigned a 0% goal for DBE, as certified by CONNDOT.

The town reserves the right to reject any or all bids, in whole or in part, if it is deemed to be in the best interest of the Town of Seymour.
