Please consider this an official request for the Product Schedule update for the 3M Cogent AFIS Schedule, referencing Master Agreement number B-04-001. 3M Cogent is offering the State of Connecticut the capability to purchase an Applicant Processing Server to enable approved Livescan devices in the State of Connecticut to electronically transmit Civilian Applicant fingerprint records. The offered Applicant Processing Server will be designed to electronically receive fingerprint records and transmit records to the CT- AFIS. There are also several related updates to the AFIS System that must be completed in order to have a fully functional Applicant Processing System. These related updates are explained in the table below:
