- 3. The Connecticut Department of Environmental Protection has changed the Agency name to The Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (D.E.E.P.)
- 4. The Connecticut Department of Emergency Management and Homeland Security has changed the Agency name to The Connecticut Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection / Division of Emergency Management and Homeland Security (DESPP).
- 5. As used throughout the Contract, the term R.O.W. includes all property owned by the State of Connecticut to include, but not be limited, to State highways, roads, state parks, state facilities, locations and properties. If municipalities use this contract and/or if the State provides assistance to municipalities, the term R.O.W. includes all property owned by the named municipality(ies) to include, but not be limited to municipal highways, roads, municipal parks, municipal facilities, locations and properties.]
- 6. The following paragraph found within Exhibit A page 19 is revised to the following:
  - III D-1.1.4 Removal of Hazardous Stumps (in R.O.W.)

Management of this debris type must be consistent with FEMA Recovery Policy – RP9523.11 entitled Hazardous Stump Extraction and Removal Eligibility, dated May 1, 2006 (review date May 1, 2009). The Contractor(s) is expected to be completely familiar with this FEMA Recovery Policy (RP9523.11)

7. Remove the term "From TDRS" from Exhibit B line item III D-1.1.4 and replace with "in R.O.W."

Note: Tree Stumps at 24" or less in diameter are to be treated at regular debris rate(s) as recognized by FEMA.

II D-1.1.4 is revised to be stated as one line item with one dimension and applicable rate as follows:
