**Item 1**

Request for Information:

- Q: Regarding the pre-engineered building, the invitation to bid indicates the building will be supplied by a Federal GSA pre-qualified manufacturer and installed by a local manufacturer approved contractor. Is the building being supplied and installed by the owner? If not, who are the pre-qualified manufacturers? Spec 133419 does not indicate any.
- A: The Contractor is responsible for providing and installing the pre-engineered metal buildings through a GSA Certified pre-engineered building contractor. - Q: Who was the contractor who installed the original spray polyurethane foam (SPF) roofing at the New London Readiness Center?
