

## NOTICE FOR MILITARY PERSONNEL INTERESTED IN THE STATE OF CONNECTICUT CORRECTION OFFICER EXAMINATION

Commissioner DeFronzo announces that the Department of Administrative Services will provide supplemental testing for military personnel who are on active military duty during the application-filing period (July 22, 2014 – August 5, 2014) and/or on the scheduled test dates for the Correction Officer examination (August 8, 2014 – August 25, 2014).

Applicants on active military duty during the application filing period, who have not submitted an application prior to the application deadline of August 5, 2014, may contact the Department of Administrative Services, Statewide Human Resources Management Division when they return from active duty to request to submit an application form and be scheduled for a supplementary examination. Applicants must provide documentation supporting that they have been on active military duty during the application-filing period and meet all minimum qualifications as detailed on the examination announcement. Military orders and a written request for supplemental application filing and testing must be faxed to 860-707-1939 or e-mailed to: [lawenforcement.exams@ct.gov](mailto:lawenforcement.exams@ct.gov).

Applicants on active military duty, who have submitted an application form but cannot participate in the testing process on any of the scheduled dates due to active military duty, must fax their military orders to the Department of Administrative Services (DAS), Statewide Human Resources Management Section at 860-707-1939 or e-mail orders to: [lawenforcement.exams@ct.gov](mailto:lawenforcement.exams@ct.gov) and request supplemental testing. Applicants must notify DAS in writing when they are discharged or are on leave and are available to participate in the testing process. Applicants must provide documentation supporting that they have been on active military duty during the scheduled test dates and meet all minimum qualifications as detailed on the examination announcement.
