AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
Central Connecticut State University
AND
Apogee Telecom, Inc

This Agreement (Contract) is entered into by and between Central Connecticut State University a constituent unit of the State of Connecticut System of Higher Education with an address of 1615 Stanley Street New Britain Connecticut 06050 (hereinafter the Institution) and Apogee Telecom Inc (hereinafter the Contractor) with a principal place of business at 1905 A Kramer Ln Austin Texas 78758 to provide television programming services to Institution in accordance with an award made to Contractor (RFP#2018 13)

I GENERAL

- 1 Contractor shall provide High Definition (HD) television programming services as available to the entire main campus in academic non academic and residential buildings on the distribution system The HD TV programming service shall include the following
 - a Service to all academic and administrative units for no additional programming costs
 - b Digital Services shall be available to digital televisions without the need for set top boxes
 - c Over The Top (OTT) Programming of channels HBO GO Max GO Showtime Anytime and any other channel that currently or in the future may offer OTT programming for residential students subscribed to linear service and Institution test accounts utilizing the Institution s BlueNet ID system and campus lightweight directory access protocol (LDAP) OTT Video Authentication for Third Party Services is incorporated into this Agreement as Exhibit A
 - d OrcaTV Campus Life Channel terms and conditions are incorporated into this Agreement as Exhibit B
 - e Fully managed headend system with extended warranty and warranty of the passive and active distribution electronics and preventative and emergency maintenance on the headend system to the closet
 - f Customizable and modifiable channel line up at any time during the contract period Institution acknowledges that modification may raise or lower total programming fees
- 2 Technical Specifications/Requirements
 - a Only equipment necessary for the reception or re processing of the Institution s selected channels and system monitoring will be permitted in the head ends The system must be plug and play at the outlet for all digital delivered services No set top converter boxes will be accepted for cable ready televisions to receive mandatory services and any additional or optional programming and/or services If a student requires a set top converter due to a non cable ready TV the Institution student will purchase them from a recommended list of vendors
 - b The Institution requires at least five channels dedicated to Institution programming
 - c The Institution requires that the Connecticut Network (CT N) be included on the Institution cable system
 - d The video feed must meet or exceed the Federal Communications Commission (hereinafter FCC) Standard in all areas The Institution may choose to translate frequencies as needed by customizing the channel allocation on the lineup
 - e The system and services must offer a method of digital video recording (DVR) by way of TIVO compatibility
 - f The system must be compliant with the June 2009 FCC digital mandate

II SCOPE OF WORK

- 1 Contractor shall provide the High Definition (HD) television programming services as selected by Institution in the Service Selection Addendum attached herein as Exhibit C Institution can amend the Service Selection Addendum to add remove or change selected programming and optional services Any change to the Service Selection Addendum shall be submitted to Contractor with a thirty (30) days notice
